

A Blended Learning Opportunity with SIM[™] Content Enhancement Routines for Planning & Leading Learning Ine Unit Organizer Routine and The Course Organizer Routine 2017-2018

The VDOE recognizes individuals' efforts and promotes the continuation and spread of evidence-based practices within schools across the Commonwealth. The table below describes items to complete in order to learn the *Unit Organizer Routine* through a self-guided and self-paced professional learning experience with the support of SIM Professional Development Leaders, Jocelyn Washburn and Helen Barrier, at the T/TAC at Virginia Tech. The KUCRL has developed a micro-credentialing system through BadgeList.com that recognizes implementation and eventually leads to the ability to instruct others. A micro-credential can function as a signal, within and outside of the system, of the educational investment made by an educator. The micro-credential can be made public via Linked In, Twitter, Facebook or on a Mozilla Backpack. A school or teacher can feature them on their websites; the badge URL can be shared on vitae and resumes. The micro-credentials can be earned individually and subsequent levels can build upon previous levels. The VDOE is showing their commitment to teachers implementing evidenced-based practices and improving outcomes for students by providing this opportunity at no expense to you.

Email a draft UO to Helen and Jocelyn and we'll follow-up to schedule a call to discuss your draft UO and discuss implementation. Make adjustments to your first UO. Complete implementation checklist while watching. In our Google Community Post one compliment and one suggestion for improvement for the video above. Launch a new unit with your students using the UO. Schedule a call with Helen or Jocelyn to debrief about your first implementation experience. Video a launch of a new unit with your students. Email video link to Helen and Jocelyn and we'll follow-up to schedule a call to share feedback on your video. Participate in a virtual conference call about use of UO Expanded Map and integrating the other CER you know with the UO. Upload evidence to Badge List. Items to post: Partner with an active SIM Professional Developer (provide Helen and Jocelyn's names). Develop a Draft Content Enhancement Routine (upload a UO).
