5 EXPLORE EXAMPLES Examples:

"We are trying to get to lunch safely, please make sure you are keeping your hands still and your mouth quiet."

"You have done a great job so far. Just keep going till I tell you to stop."

"I really like that you have started your paragraph off with a clear topic sentence. That's exactly right. Now let's see if we can think of 3 related detail sentence you could write to turn that topic sentence into a paragraph."

Nonexamples:

"If I have to keep telling you not to talk I am going to have to call home and tell them about your behavior."

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7 TIE DOWN A DEFINITION

Positive corrective feedback is a high leverage practice, linked to a goal, immediately after a student response that gives specific information and next steps.
