The name of the theme or larger category that includes several units together. - Helps students understand how multiple units relate.

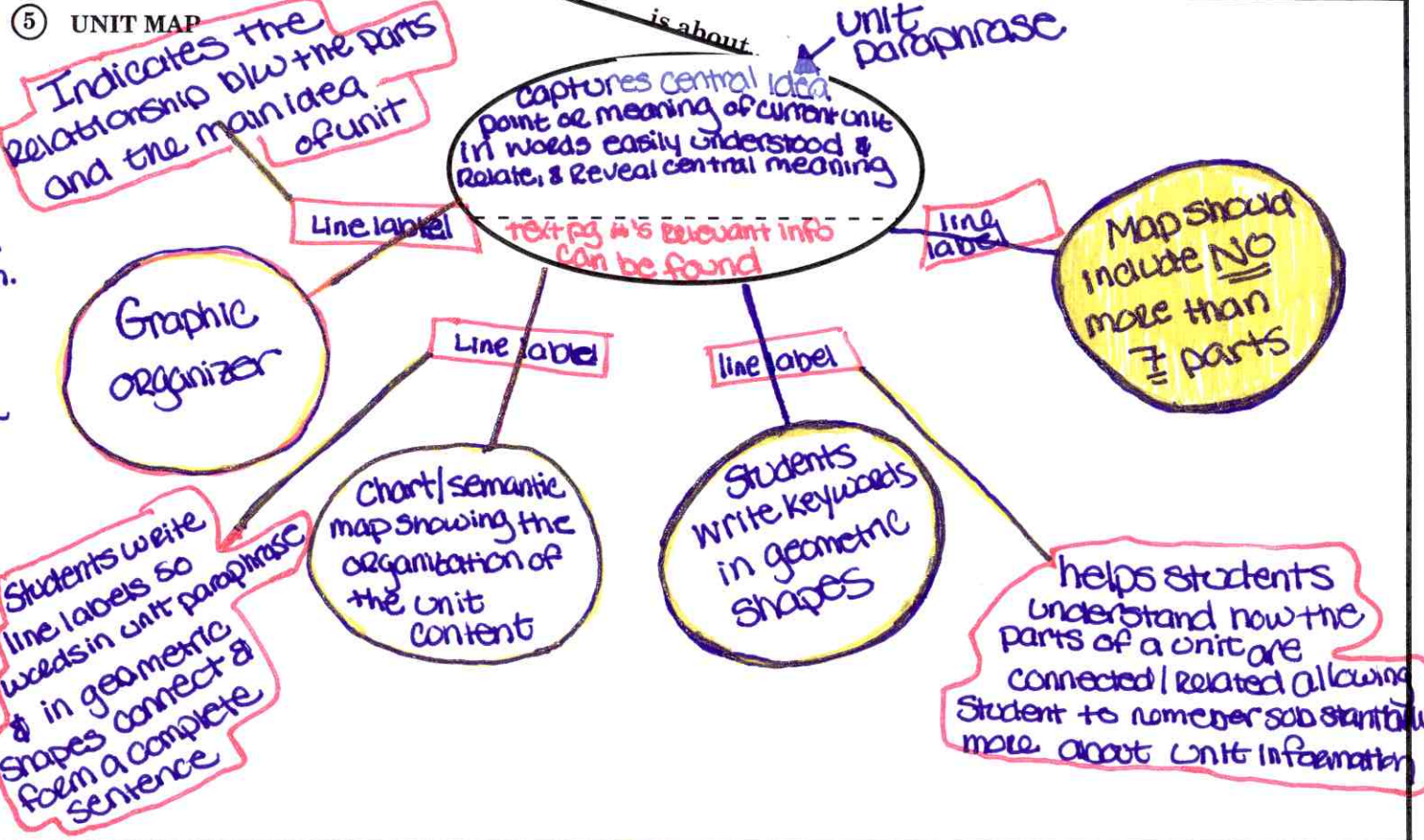
2 LAST UNIT/Experience

When preparing for unit test students can ask themselves those questions to review the content of the unit.

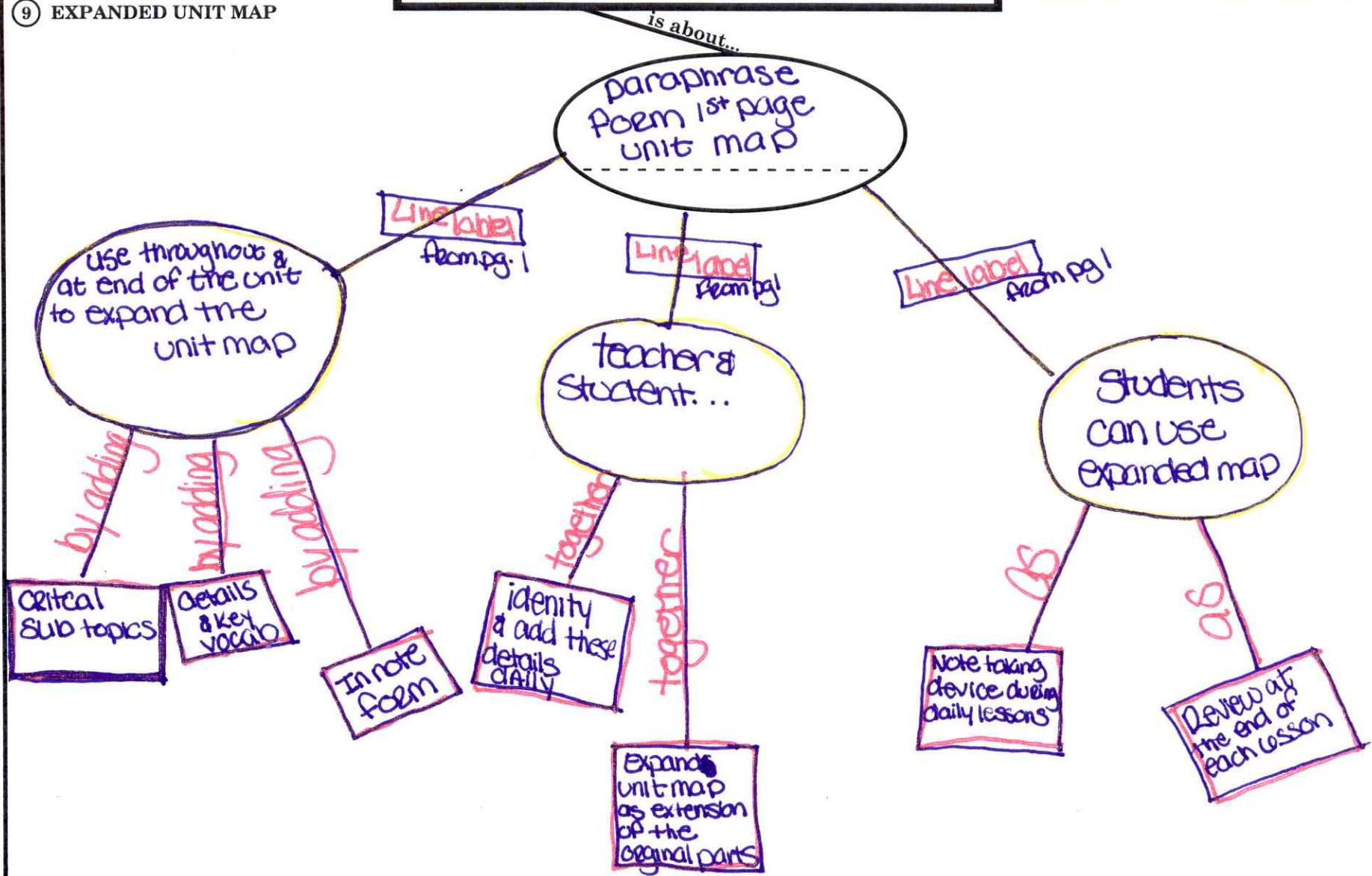
