a collaborative process to develop, implement and refine a lesson that includes a Content Enhancement Routine

⑤ ■ Use it to describe...

□ Example of...

- a way to develop, assess the effectiveness of and refine a lesson and the CER draft device that is a part of it

⑥ ■ Don't confuse it with...

□ Not an example of...

- Teacher evaluation
- Just collaborative planning
- Each teacher drafting her or his own device and implementing it her or his own way.

② Clarifiers

- Collaborative lesson development
- Helps determine effectiveness of draft
- Helps determine if the CER is a good match for the content
- While lesson is taught, data is collected on how lesson impacts student learning, including expected Cue-Do-Review student behaviors
- Focus is not on the teacher delivering the lesson
- Follows the lesson study cycle

④ Knowledge connections

- To me, studying means you keep working on something until you get it right.
- I usually have to edit a draft device a few times until it is really what I want.
- I feel like I get the best draft when I develop it with others.

⑦ Example sentence

During the lesson study which included use of the Concept Mastery Routine, we observed that student engagement seemed to decline during the lesson and discussed either breaking the routine up over several days or using small white boards to encourage all students to participate in co-construction.
