The Strategic Instruction Model (SIM)

Is about ...

An integrated model of research-validated practices to address many needs of diverse adolescent learners

Main idea

Content Enhancement Routines (CE)

Used to increase understanding of content

Used with the whole class (Tier 1)

Teacher determines when use is appropriate based on complexity of content

Cue-Do-Review instructional sequence can be implemented in a single class period (through results are better with routine use)

Main idea

Learning Strategies (LS)

Used to teach students an effective and efficient way of doing a task or skill

An academic intervention used with specific students needing additional practice to learn a skill (Tier 2 or 3)

Use is determined by a student scoring below mastery on a pre test

May take 4 weeks or more of instruction to move students to mastery (depending on the strategy)

So what? What is important to understand about this?

CE & LS are designed for different purposes. For SIM to make a positive difference for students, teachers must match the desired student outcome with the appropriate SIM practice.
