Preview

- Preview a specific topic-gather information about it (don't worry about organizing the ideas).
- ® Preview audience and goals think about who the audience will be and what you hope will happen when they read your work.

List main ideas and details on the Frame Think Sheet

Solution State & St

Assign numbers to indicate the best order for writing ideas

- ® Decide which main ideas to write about firs, second, third, etc..
- Some of the second of the order for presenting details...
- ® Make sure the order makes sense.
- ® In the bubbles on the Frame, note numbers to indicate the order of ideas.

Note ideas in complete sentences

- ® Begin with a sentence or two that activates the reader's background knowledge about your subject.
- Next, introduce the topic of your essay and what it will be about
- Sollow your planned order for writing. Each new main idea and its supporting details should be in a new paragraph.
- ® Write at least 2 sentences about each detail.
- Tell yourself positive statements abut yourself and tell yourself to write more.

Search for errors and correct

- ® Read your paper aloud to find and fix...
 - Sentences that do not make sense, and
 - o Incomplete or run-on sentences.
- ® Read your paper silently to find and fix
 - Spelling and punctuation errors,
 - Switching tense errors, and
 - o Mixing singular/plural subjects/verbs.
