

## Inference Strategy

means when you make a guess about something using clues

### Step 1: **Interact with the questions and passage.**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Skim over the passage
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read the title
- \_\_\_\_\_ See how long the passage is
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read the questions

### Step 2: **Note what you know.**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Underline clue words in the question
- \_\_\_\_\_ Decide what kind of question it is
- \_\_\_\_\_ Write the code letter

- F = Fact question
- B = Big Picture question
- P = Predicting question
- C = Clarifying question

### Step 3: **Find the clues**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Read the story
- ↕
- \_\_\_\_\_ Look for clues to answer the questions
- ↕
- \_\_\_\_\_ Underline the clues

### Step 4: **Explore the supporting details**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Are there any more clues to underline?

### Step 5: **Return to the question**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Mark the answer to the question
