Content Enhancement Routines

Essential details

What?

increases understanding and supports application of content in course standards

Who?

Whole class of students (Tier 1)

When?

Teacher decides based on challenging content, and/or students may have gaps in needed background

How?

Apprenticeship learning: students & teacher co-construct knowledge through conversation following Cue-Do-Review instructional sequence

☐ Main idea

Learning Strategies

Essential details

teaches students an effective and efficient way of doing a task or skill (intervention)

specific students needing additional practice to learn a skill (Tier 2 or 3)

Pre-tests results indicates student is scoring below mastery

Gradual Release w/ intensive progress monitoring, student proceeds only upon showing mastery of each step, concludes with generalization

So What? (What's important to understand about this?)

Students with disabilities can be highly successful when given needed supports and scaffolds. Specialized instruction is part of this.
