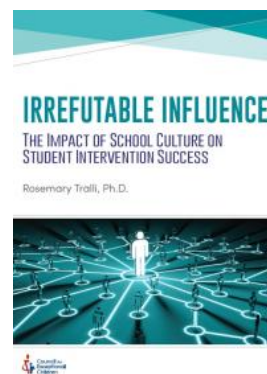

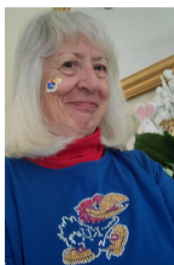
Irrefutable Influence: The Impact of SIM on the Development of a New Book!
