SIM in the Field

Florida Project Makes a Big Impact in School Participation and Adolescent Reading - from OSEP's April 2023 Update

The Florida State Personnel Development Grant (SPDG) supports Check and

<u>Connect</u> implementation. In schools at the initial to full implementation stages of Check and Connect, 85% of students with disabilities showed progress or met the target for attendance. This was 15% greater than the target set.



Additionally, the Florida SPDG supports the Strategic Instruction Model (SIM). In schools at the initial or full implementation stages of SIM, 90% of students who participated in the reading intervention showed progress or met the grade-level reading target. This was 20% greater than the target set.

Together, these data represent impact for more than 1300 students.
