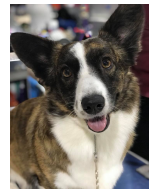

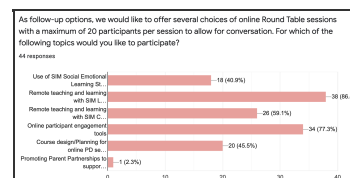
• **Webinar: Delivering Online SIM™ Professional Development**
