


# Strategic Instruction Model™ Project

## **Key SIM Project Information**

The **State Personnel Development Grant (SPDG)**, under the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP), provides grants to help state educational agencies (SEAs) reform and improve their systems for personnel preparation and professional development of individuals providing early intervention, educational, and transition services to improve results for children with disabilities.

	Strategic Instruction Model™ (SIM)				

The **Strategic Instruction Model<sup>TM</sup> (SIM)** developed by the University of Kansas Center for Research on Learning (KUCRL) is an integrated model of evidence-based teaching strategies and routines that support the development of adolescent literacy across content areas. **Content Enhancement Routines (CERs)** make challenging course standards and content accessible for (*Tier 1*) all through high quality teacher planning and integrated scaffolds to support the learning of students with disabilities and those who struggle. **Learning Strategies (LS)** are intervention curricula (*Tier 2 & 3*) that help students overcome specific learning difficulties that impede literacy. LS has several major strands including reading, writing, studying, and interacting. **LiveBinders** for each Content Enhancement Routine (CER) or Learning Strategy (LS) provide example, electronic templates and other implementation supports. Links can be found in professional development materials and in EDU classes.

**EDU (sim.edu20.org)** is the Learning Management System used for SIM professional learning sessions. This system is used for teachers to submit assignments, evidence of implementation and implementation reflections. It also houses **content specific groups** (Math, ELA, Science, Social Studies) where teachers can access sample devices and resources for implementing.

**Basecamp** is the project management software used by SPDG SIM Staff to communicate with stakeholders. This tool will be used mostly by DIT members, SIT members and SIM Site Coordinators. Those who need to access Basecamp will receive email invitations with relevant links.
