 Lexile scores match reader ability and text difficulty, allowing individualized monitoring of student progress.


How does it work?

 Lexile measures are based on two well-established predictors of how difficult a text is to comprehend: semantic difficulty (word frequency) and syntactic complexity (sentence length). Lexile Score Table from www.texite.com:
